3. Status of Memberships by Sri E. Madhava Rao, JS 1

Sri Madhava Rao presented that there are 141 members having different category of memberships prior to the 21st Annual Meet held on 07.01.2024. With 12 new memberships on 07.01.2024, there are 153 members as on date from ordinary membership to Chief Patron category. Details are enclosed as Annexure-1.

4. Status of preparation/ issue of Membership cards by Sri SSK Tulasi Rao, OS.

Sri Tulasi Rao informed that a total of 103 Membership cards were prepared in 3 batches from 2017 to 2023 and 82 cards were issued (Annexure-2). Remaining 21 cards could not be issued since the concerned members were absent in the subsequent Annual Meets held after the cards are made. Cards for newly eligible members will be prepared by 31.12.2024.

5. Status of membership related activity by “Membership Committee” Chairman Sri A. Suresh, JS 2

In the 1st ECM held on 07-04-2024 a Sub-committee was formed to carry out all works related to Membership under the Chairmanship of Sri A. Suresh. Sri Maruthi Prasad, a member of the Sub-committee, presented the details of the work carried out by the Sub-committee.

The Sub-committee collected the phone numbers of the previous members (Hand-Book-2023) who do not have both LL and mobile numbers. It prepared the Membership Directory-2024 by combining (i) the data of 407 members available in the Hand Book-2023, (ii) details of 506 new members collected by Sri Suresh and (iii) the details of 30 new members attended the 21st Annual Meet on 07.01.2024 and uploaded the Directory into Google drive which can be accessed by the members through an email (gpvaah@gmail.com).

The Membership Directory-2024 contains the following information:

- Details of 943 members year-wise
- Details of 943 members branch-wise
- Details of 943 members in alphabetical order

When formed, the Sub-committee was requested to complete the task by 31.07.2024. The EC congratulated the Sub-committee for completing the task well before the given PDC. Preparation of “List of Entrepreneurs” is one of the mandates given to Sub-committee on 07.04.2024; the Directory-2024 will be more useful if this is also added to it. Sri Rangayyappa Rao requested Sri Maruthi Prasad to bifurcate the list of 943 members into two parts; part 1 containing details of 153 paid members and part 2 containing details of 790 members and make a digital book by combining these two parts. **Action: Sri Suresh and Maruthi.**

6. Cost break-up for “New facilities and Repairs at GPV” by Sri VV Krishna Mohan.

The Principal, GPV submitted a list of new facilities/works required at GPV in the Annual Meet held on 29.01.2023. These works were discussed in 3rd and 4th EC meetings held in the year 2023 and the Principal was asked to submit detailed break up for these works in December 2023. Instead of giving details for each work and its cost, the Principal sent a separate list of requirements on

14.07.2024 (Annexure-3). Secretary was asked to communicate the principal for details of each work and its cost by 22.07.2024.

7. Joining of one lady member into EC

At present there are no lady members in our Association. Therefore, in the previous ECM Professor Murty requested all the members to join one lady member in the Executive Committee. For this requirement Secretary contacted Mrs. Satyavani, Metallurgy lecturer at GPV in April and July 2024 to recommend one lady member and till now no member is recommended. In view of this, the Secretary requested all the EC members to try for a lady member through their sources. Sri N. Srinivasa Rao, JS 3 has come forward and took the responsibility for this task. He was asked to complete the task by 31.07.2024.

8. Status of preparation of “Proceedings of 21st Annual Meet held on 07.01.2024” by the Secretary

Secretary informed that the required information due from JS 1 and Treasurer was received in the last week of June 2024. In view of this and as well as due to his personal activities, Secretary will write the draft Proceedings and discuss them with Professor Murty by 31.08.2024. The final version will be circulated in the EC members group as well as uploaded on the website.

9. Industrial visit to mobilize funds

Details collected at registration counters in the previous Annual Meet by the Treasurer contain some information on Industrialists. These details were handed over to Sri G. Ramesh Kumar, EC Member and asked to separate the information on Industrialists. Sri G. Ramesh Kumar will also contact these industrialists for details of other industrialists known to them. Final list will be handed over to the Secretary by 31-08-2024 and the Secretary will finalize the dates for industrial visit in September 2024, after consulting Advisory Committee members.

10. Procurement of land to build our Association office

Sri SLN Sastry requested the Director of IIIT to give 300 Sq. Yds land on lease for construction of GPVAAH Office building for which the Director did not agree. The EC requested Sri Sastry to continue his efforts by involving Professor Murty and Dr. Venkateswara Rao. Discussions also took place on merits and demerits of purchasing / taking on rent a residential apartment in Hyderabad; no conclusion drawn.

11. Introducing welfare schemes for poor members of GPVAAH

This point was well discussed in previously held two Annual Meets. All the GB members were requested to identify and recommend poor members (Alumni of GPVVH only) for extending help from our Association. Till now no recommendation is received by the Association. In view of this, all the EC members were requested to identify poor members through circulations in other Whatsapp groups of GPV. Sri K. Rangayyappa Rao told that he is ready to help one or two members immediately, if genuine members are identified.

12. Implement / fulfil the responsibilities allotted as per the approved Organisational Chart

Sri Rangayyappa Rao informed that the Organisational Chart was prepared with lot of efforts with a view that junior members will extend their support to senior members and was approved by the previous GB. He said that it is to be implemented strictly and requested all the EC members for their cooperation.

13. Any other points with permission of Chair

- i) Sri N. Srinivasa Rao, JS 3 will note down the points discussed in the EC meetings and prepare draft minutes within 10 days which will be finalized by the Secretary in another 5 days. The minutes will be sent to Sri Rangayyappa Rao for his scrutiny before obtaining final approval from the President.
- ii) Sri SSK Tulasi Rao, OS and Sri NNR Pavan Babu, EC member to take care of stage arrangements, water, banners, seating arrangement and other logistics during Annual Meets.
- iii) Sri Madhava Rao, JS 1 to take care of purchase of mementos, shawls, gifts for lady participants, printing of new year calendars, mike and projector arrangements, invitations to 1968 to 1990 batches etc. for the Annual Meets.
- iv) Sri K Durga Nageswara Rao, Treasurer will take care of two cash counters for registration related activities with 3 members of his choice at each counter.
- v) No registration fee for the family (only wife) of the members having Ordinary Membership.
- vi) Sri K. Veerabhadra Rao was working as Vice President of GPVAAH from 2015. However, in the Advisory Committee meeting held on 07-04-2024, he was shifted from EC to AC. Sri Veerabhadra Rao attended this EC meeting as an Invitee and wants to continue as a member of the EC instead of working in AC. The Vice president did not agree for this proposal. Based on his previous services to the Association, the EC decided to give him Invitation related works (inviting members passed upto 1967) for the Annual Meets.
- vii) All new EC members to take Life Membership in one month time by paying Rs.10,000 or more.
- viii) One lecturer from GPT, Gannavaram approached Sri SLN Sastry for furniture requirements. Sri Sastry garu donated 20 tables and few electronic equipment in June 2024, after due approval by his Director.
- ix) Important messages in EC Members Whatsapp Group are getting diluted by many greeting messages related to Birthday and Wedding anniversary of the members. In view of this it is decided to maintain 3 Whatsapp Groups:
